Maxwell Foster began music as a young child and was accepted into the Queensland Young Conservatorium of Music at the age of eight where he studied under Jenni Flemming. After winning many awards in his home state of Queensland and completing his AMusA. Maxwell made the huge step (at age 13) of moving to Melbourne to study with Rita Reichman and to attend the Australian National Academy of Music.

In 2008 Maxwell won (after completing a whole year of elimination rounds) the prestigious ABC Symphony Australia Young Performers Award. As well as winning this award Maxwell was the recipient of the biennial David Paul Landa Memorial Scholarship for pianists. Maxwell has played many recitals (including a recital in the wonderful Utzon room of the Sydney Opera House) and has played with Queensland's St. Lucia Orchestra, Melbourne's Pro Musica, Orchestra Victoria, the Queensland Orchestra and the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra.

Further to these performances Maxwell has been invited to play recitals in Queensland and with Musica Viva in Melbourne and Sydney . He has also been invited to perform with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra, Melbourne's Pro Musica, Melbourne Symphony Orchestra and Sydney Symphony Orchestra.

Maxwell is a boarder on scholarship at Scotch College Melbourne where he also plays Viola in the school groups and Senior Orchestra. Maxwell loves to play chamber music whenever he finds the opportunity or time!!!
