

## Additional instructions for Dance applicants for Appalachian Spring Project

As well as completing the online application form, which can be found at <https://my.aso.com.au/auxiliary/Reserve.aspx?p=1350&promo=schools> dancers are required to do the following:

- Please upload to a private YouTube channel as an unlisted video (so that it can only be viewed by people you have given the link to) 2 contrasting segments of approximately 2 - 2.5 mins each of you expressing yourself through dance
- Once your footage is uploaded, please email the link to Vicki McGregor, Learning and Community Engagement Coordinator at the ASO at [mcmgregorv@aso.com.au](mailto:mcmgregorv@aso.com.au) . Please also include your full name in this email so your footage can be matched to your online application.
- You can be dancing as part of an ensemble but you must describe your position in the email and be able to be clearly seen.
- An improvisation is fine - it need not be performance material.
- The quality of the video is not paramount here so filmed with a mobile phone and uploaded is fine, as long as you are clearly able to be seen.
- You will receive an email confirming receipt of the link, completing your application, within 1 business day. If you do not receive this email, please contact Vicki McGregor on 8233 6246.
- If you have had any creative/choreographic experience please include that in the online form in the field under Primary instrument/skill where it says "If other, please specify".
